



IOF ONLINE EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

**READ VERY CAREFULLY,
DO NOT IGNORE ANY INFORMATION**

- 1. Appear for examination as per given time. You can login 15 minutes before the time. All mentioned times are Indian Standard Time.**
- 2. Make sure that pop-up blocker is disabled on your browser before logging in for the examination.**
- 3. Once logged-in through one browser tab, user cannot login from any other browser/same browser tab.**
- 4. If internet speed is unreasonably slow, images and tables in the questions may take little longer to appear.**
- 5. This is a Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) type examination. You can go back to the previous questions. There is no negative marking.**
- 6. Once an examination is attempted, you can not appear for it again. Examination window will be activated on the declared time and date only.**
- 7. You should manage your time wisely and not spend too much time on any one question. A timer is present on the console which will help you to keep track of time during the course of the examination.**
- 8. Once submitted, no modifications to the answers or reattempt of any questions is possible. Check your work before you submit it.**
- 9. Duration of examination is one hour. You cannot pause the timer or test in between. Answers will be submitted automatically after one hour from the time student begins.**

10. Try to attempt all the questions as no Negative marking is applied in this examination.

11. Keep sufficient power / electricity backup. IOF is not responsible for any electricity power failure. Laptop / notebooks /phones must be fully charged having sufficient backup time during examination or use cyber cafe where such power backup solution is available.

12. Use faster, reliable and continued internet connection. Do not use internet connection which frequently disconnects or having any other issues.

13. IOF is not responsible for any losses due to unavailability of time, disconnection of internet, electricity, hacking of email id, unavailability of proper knowledge of computer / internet, misuse of email id, misuse of your login key by someone.

14. We have tested all the Login Details before sending it. Avoid any login key typing mistake like - Don't use extra space before or after username or password.

15. Olympiads will be conducted online and the students will have to take the exams from their residence or any other place where they have access to computer with good Internet connectivity.

16. The Online Olympiads are to be taken through Windows Desktop/Windows Laptop/Windows Tablet/Android Tablet/Android Smart Phone connected with broadband internet using Chrome Browser Only.

17. Camera is required for appearing in IOF Olympiads. You will not be able to appear in our Olympiads if you do not have a working camera in your Windows Computer/Tablet or Android Smart Phone.

18. Scheduled Online exam can NOT be changed, postponed or extended except only if decided by IOF. IOF will not be responsible for any losses due to unavailability of time, disconnection of internet, electricity, hacking of email id, unavailability of proper knowledge of computer / internet, misuse of email id, misuse of your login key by someone. No repeat or extra examination attempt is provided.

19. Registration itself will not fetch a participation certificate. Students who will appear for Olympiad and attempt the Olympiad will be eligible for awards as per table given above.

20. Results for Olympiads will be declared by 31 January 2024. Each winner will be entitled to one award for a subject. The winners will be entitled to the higher level award only. For example, a zonal topper can be international topper as well, in that case he/she will be eligible to get only International Topper Award and not Zonal Award.

21. Gold, Silver and Bronze refer to colors of the medals and not to actual metals of same names. All Medals are Gold / Silver / Bronze color plated as applicable.

22. Question Papers and Answer Key of Current Year are made available on our website in July/August of next year.

23. There is no level system in IOF Olympiads. IOF evaluation process is totally computer oriented and generated. No request for reevaluation will be entertained.

24. Any prizes won by students will be sent to school for distribution to students and not to students directly or individually.

25. Use of any unfair means will result in disqualification. If any person other than student registered for Olympiad is visible in the camera during examination, the student will be disqualified. If any means are used to record the Question Paper like video recording, photographs of questions etc. are taken, student will be disqualified. If you try to switch browser tabs between the Olympiad, the test will be auto submitted after three warnings.
